INVITATION

SOC DAB and NTR College of Veterinary Science, Gannavaram, Andhra Pradesh are jointly organizing the XXI Annual Convention of Society for Conservation of Domestic Animal Biodiversity and National Symposium on “Animal production systems and its role in sustainable use of AnGR” on 15th – 16th February. 2024.

The Society :

The Society for Conservation of Domestic Animal Biodiversity (SOC DAB) was established in the year 1998 at National Bureau of Animal Genetic Resources (NBAGR), Karnal, Haryana, India with an objective to create awareness among general public about domestic animal diversity and their conservation, undertake activities to foster sustainable management of domestic animals, judicious use of animal genetic resources and to promote research, education and development of domestic animals. The Society is publishing a research journal (Journal of Livestock Biodiversity) and organising National Symposium annually.



The Host :

NTR College of Veterinary Science, Gannavaram established in 1998, situated in suburban region of Vijayawada city is a constituent college of Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University, Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh. Andhra Pradesh state is the home tract of Ongole cattle, Godavari buffalo, Nellore, Macherla and Nagavali Sheep, and Kalasthi chicken.

Scientific Programme :

The deliberations of the symposium will focus on the following topics:

Day 1 : Feb 15th, 2024

1. *Deciphering the Domestic Animal Bio-diversity: Status and Challenges (Status phenotypic Characterisation, evaluation and conservation)*
2. *Omic approaches for enhanced and sustainable livestock productivity (Advanced tools for genomics, reproduction biotechnology and genetic characterisation)*

Day 2 : Feb 16th, 2024

3. *Management approaches and value addition of native breeds*
4. *Young Scientist Awards*
5. *Brain storming session - AnGR Conservation Priorities: Status and way forward*

Annual General Body Meeting of SOC DAB will be conducted on the evening of 15th February, 2024.

Call for Research Abstracts :

Research abstracts to be presented in the national seminar on the themes detailed. The full length papers / abstracts are to be submitted to the Organising Secretary on or before **14th January, 2024**. Full length papers should be limited to ten pages and abstracts to be limited to 300 words typed in 12 font size (Times New Roman) in 1.5 line spacing. These should contain the objectives of the study brief methodology, results and conclusion.

The abstract should include the title (in title case), Full names (in BLOCK) of author(s), The name of the presenting author needs to be underlined. Location where study was carried out (in title case and in italics). Include a separate line of e-mail for correspondence.

Selected papers will be considered for oral presentation and the remaining will be allotted for poster presentation. Poster size should be 3'x4' (WxL).

Papers or abstracts may be sent via email (**socdab2024@gmail.com**) as an attachment. Abstracts not in prescribed format will not be entertained.

Research Awards and Opportunities :

Best Oral and Poster Presentation

To encourage research in the thematic areas among the researchers, society confers different awards to the participants. The first and second best oral and poster presentations in each technical session will be awarded prize and certificates.

SOC DAB Fellow Award (2024)

Society had invited the application on the prescribed format. Applications will be judged based on the score card for SOC DAB-FELLOW, being circulated separately by the society.

Young Scientist Award (2024)

To inspire the young researchers, SOC DAB has the 'Young Scientist Award'. Lead/First Author must be below 35 years of age (as on 01.01.2024) and life member of the Society. Full paper should be submitted with marked clearly as “For Young Scientist Award”. Authorship is limited to two only and work presented should be unpublished from the thesis/ research project of the scientist. Kindly note that abstracts of all the research articles received in this category will be published in the Compendium of the Symposium, whereas, it will be mandatory to submit the full text articles to the Journal of Livestock Biodiversity being published by the society.

Dr. D. S. Balain Memorial Award (2024)

The Society shall award Dr. D. S. Balain Memorial for the Best Research Scientist in any Animal Sciences discipline. Applications for the award will be invited separately from the life-members of society. The awardee will be honoured with a citation and cash prize.

Prof. K.N. Sharma Memorial Award (2023 -24)

The award will be given to the best research paper published in Indian Journal of Animal Sciences and Journal of Livestock Biodiversity on Animal production in calendar year 2021 and 2022. The applicant should be a Life-Member of the Society for The applicant should be a Life-Member of the Society for Conservation of Domestic Animal Biodiversity (SOC DAB) for at least five years.

SOC DAB secretariat will invite application separately.

National AnGR Quiz Competition

A National level quiz competition for UG students of SAU/SVU will be held and prior to the National Quiz, four zonal quiz competition will be held. The students will be quizzed on “Livestock Biodiversity of India and Its conservation”. The zonal winners (teams of 2 students +1 mentor) shall be competing during the conference. Travel grant for the Zonal winners (students only) to attend the National Symposium 2023 by Railway (AC-3 Tier), will be provided by the SOC DAB society.

Travel and Accommodation :

Gannavaram is well connected to the main- stream city Vijayawada on the Chennai- Kolkata highway (NH-16). Vijayawada is well connected to rest of the states by both rail and air. The college is located just opposite to Vijayawada airport



and is about 18 km from Vijayawada railway junction. During the month of February, weather will be pleasant with temperature ranging between 30-35°C. Limited accommodation is available in University guest houses. However Accommodation can be arranged in nearby hotels on prior request. Following are the approximate tariff rates. Free accommodation with basic amenities will be provided for the first few students / scholars on first come-first served basis.

Tourist places of interest:

Vijayawada spreads on the banks of river Krishna in Andhra Pradesh. The famous Kanaka Durga Temple, Undavalli Caves, Amaravathi (place of Buddhist relics), Kuchipudi (Origin place of Kuchipudi Dance), Mangalagiri (Handlooms), Kondapalli Fort, Bhavani Islands and Mary Mata Temple are the major tourist places in and around the city.
